## PREPARATION OF THE CALENDAR OF MEETINGS

1. At its ninetieth session, held in Geneva on October 28, 2015, the Consultative Committee requested the Office of the Union to prepare a document with options and possible impacts of holding the sessions of the bodies that meet in Geneva consecutively, only once a year (see document CC/90/19 "Report on the Conclusions", paragraph 85). This matter will be discussed under agenda item 24 "Organization of the UPOV sessions" (document CC/92/17).
2. The Technical Working Party for Fruit Crops (TWF), at its forty-seventh session, to be held in Angers, France, from November 14 to 18, 2016, will agree on the date and place of its forty-eighth session in 2017. The TWF will consider an invitation from Canada to hold its forty-eighth session from September 18 to 22, 2017, in Kelowna, British Columbia, Canada, with a preparatory workshop on September 17, 2017.
3. The Administrative and Legal Committee (CAJ), at its seventy-third session, will consider the program for its seventy-fourth session. The conclusions of the CAJ, on the scheduling of its sessions, will be reported to the Consultative Committee, at its ninety-second session. If appropriate, the Consultative Committee may wish to make a recommendation to the Council, at its fiftieth ordinary session, to be held on October 28, 2016, to revise the "Calendar of Meetings in 2017" (document C/50/8).
4. *The Consultative Committee is invited to consider the scheduling of UPOV sessions, and, if appropriate, make a recommendation to the Council, at its fiftieth ordinary session, to be held on October 28, 2016, to revise the "Calendar of Meetings in 2017" (document C/50/8).*
